Dear Families,

It's been great to get back into school life for 2024, and see our school community settling in also. Staff and students have spent their first two weeks setting up routines and environments that are conducive to learning and success. I have heard many conversations about positive mindsets, being resilient in our learning and showing persistence.

In Week 0 our staff team reviewed our Parent Engagement Data from 2023, including identifying strengths and areas that we will focus to improve on in 2024. It was pleasing to read the positive comments that had been included in the survey from our parent community. This data was also discussed at last night's Governing Council AGM, and I was extremely excited to have very similar conversations with our parent representatives that I had with staff! Throughout these conversations our staff team have set goals to increase our conversations about learning and the intentional use of Language for Learning.

This will look like posts on Seesaw that state a Learning Intention or a purpose – something similar to "we are learning to..." or "students learned about..." or "we are exploring..." We invite our families to interact with these posts – ask further questions, comment about the learning or encourage the children. These photos and posts can also be excellent conversation starters at home! Teachers and children can both see comments that are posted to them, and this will support everyone to be involved in conversations about learning.

Last night we held our Beginning Year BBQ, Open Classrooms and Governing Council AGM. Thank you to all families who joined us for the BBQ and Open Classrooms – it was a lovely, casual evening with interactive activities and sharing about learning in our classrooms. 
There are so many exciting things happening at Beachport this year!
